India shines among top 10 ultra-high net wealthy nations

AMONG THE TOP 10 nations with ultra-high-net-worth (UHNW) individual, India is the only one which saw an increase in the number of ultra-wealthy population in 2022, on the back of rising capital inflows, resilient urban consumer demand and extensive infrastructure development, according to Altrata World Ultra Wealth Report 2023.

While the global UHNW population fell by 5.4% to 3,95,070 individuals — the first annual decline in four years and the largest contraction since 2015 — India saw an increase of 3.2% to 8,880 individuals. The US, which ranks number one in UHNW population, saw a decline of 4.3% in 2022. Similarly, China's UHNW population declined 7% to 47,190. Japan recorded the sharpest fall recorded of 22% to 14,940, followed by Hong Kong. Currency effects played a major role in Japan, with the yen depreciating by 16% against the US dollar.

The combined net worth of India's UHNW population is \$1.4 trillion. For the US, it is \$15 trillion and that of China at \$5.3 trillion. The total net worth of the UHNW population declined by 5.5% to \$45.4 trillion in 2022, second-largest annual fall in the past decade.

An UHNW individual has been defined as a person with a net worth of \$30 million or more. The combined net worth of India's UHNW population accounted for 33% of the total wealth held by all HNW individuals.

because of the Russia-Ukraine war, soaring commodity prices and extreme volatility in the global stock markets disrupted wealth markets around the world. The heightened risk-off sentiment and weakened asset markets shifted the focus to wealth preservation, which proved challenging.

"Rising inflation triggered aggressive monetary policy tightening for the first time in more than a decade, prompting a re-evaluation of capital market risk and returns," the report says. Bond markets slumped and most leading stock market indices posted double-digit falls.

The 10 largest ultra wealth markets are all located across three regions, with four in Europe, two in Asia and two in North America. This trend has remained unchanged over the past decade. The report says the UHNW populations and wealth would increase across each of the seven main regions over the next five years, although rates of expansion will vary.

Asia is projected to record the strongest growth in its ultra-wealthy population in its cumulative net worth, lifting the region's share of global UHNW wealth to 29% (up from 27% in 2022 and just 15% in 2004).

"An expanding Indian economy will be a key driver, as will the trend for businesses to 'regionalise' and diversify their operations away from the Chinese mainland, supporting industrial, logistical and real estate activity in other key Asian markets," the report highlights.

In twilight of his career, Bopanna steps out of shadows of Indian greats

FOR A PLAYER that has spent most of the last two decades at the elite level of professional sport — including 20 years of Davis Cup and back-to-back appearances at the Olympics — Rohan Bopanna has, for the most part, shown nothing but pride that most of his records are prefixed with the word 'oldest'.

Earlier this year, after he had Ebdon won the prestigious Indian Wells Masters — known in India as the men's doubles Grand Slam — he became the oldest player to win a Masters 1000 title. Shortly after, at 43, he became the oldest player in the top 10 and top 100 of the world rankings. And by reaching the final on Friday, he became the oldest player to reach a Grand Slam men's doubles final in the Open era.

The veteran Indian and his Australian partner Matthew Ebden reached the US Open final following a straight-set win over the French pair of Pierre-Hugues Herbert and Nicolas Mahut at Flushing Meadows.

It was Bopanna's first appearance in the men's doubles final of a Major since 2010 when he played — and lost — the summit clash at the same venue as this weekend as Pakistan's Aisam-ul-Haq Qureshi.

While speaking to the press before his 14th appearance at Wimbledon in July, Bopanna was blunt in his belief of what has led to his longevity at the top level of the sport.

"Mental strength, I think, is my biggest strength," he said. "It's what has helped me grow over the years and sustain it. If you don't have a strong mental, you'll be like a sailing vessel, or my forehead is firing, I find ways to use those things to win matches. And all of it comes from the mind. It's the thing that's kept



me fresh, adapting to new challenges, and doing new things to keep going."

Every inch of that mental resilience was on display throughout Bopanna's remarkable US Open run, which featured gritty, arduous games — Bopanna and Ebden saved 14 of the 15 break points they faced in the quarterfinal and semifinal all-as well as a testing third-round match against the French pair of Pierre-Hugues Herbert and Nicolas Mahut at Flushing Meadows.

His aforementioned records not only speak to the incredible physical resilience of the Indian, but also to the unquestionable effectiveness of the hefty amount of work that has gone into keeping his body and mind fit and fresh, including an emphasis on recovery, including yoga and meditation. "I've been a travelling yogi and an unlikely renaissance thanks to yoga."

Yoga-led comeback
Having pivoted to doubles

early, where his firepower serve and ability to find acute angles with his forehand were big assets. Bopanna spent most of the 2010s as one of the consistent players on the doubles circuit, winning 4 Masters 1000 titles and reaching the 2010 US Open final alongside Pakistan's Aisam-ul-Haq Qureshi.

In 2017, he won his maiden Grand Slam title, winning mixed doubles at the French Open alongside Gabriela Dabrowski and reached another mixed doubles Major final at the 2018 Australian Open. But as he approached 40, injuries and physical issues continued to mount. Eventually, debilitating knee pain after heruptured and lost cartilage in both his knees made him question his future as a player.

An unlikely turn to 'yengar' yoga not only helped with his knee pain but also helped him mentally reset his mind during the lockdown-induced isola-

tion. Instead of merely being about breathing, 'yengar' yoga has been described as 'yoga as exercise' which Bopanna credited for the strengthening of his muscles, building his mobility, and assisting in his recovery.

Since then, his physical fitness has been cared for meticulously alongside his long-term coach, Scott Davidoff, as well as Rebecca Van Orsaelgen, the Belgian physio he has invested in to travel with him on tour this year. At his age, he has been focusing more on recovery than he has on endurance training.

"If (yoga) really made the difference," Bopanna was quoted as saying by the ATP. "I said 'Okay.' Then when I started playing, I felt pain-free. And then that was a whole new ballgame."

Understated among greats

Bopanna has not broken new ground at the US Open this

year. It's not even his first Major final of the year. But the other one was overshadowed by his mixed doubles partner — the Australian Open being the final Grand Slam of Sania Mirza's career.

Mirza, perhaps rightly, took all the plaudits from that run, summarising Bopanna's underplayed status among modern Indian tennis greats. He has been through a lot of larger-than-life personalities who dominated Indian tennis like few others.

Leader Paes won India's second individual medal at the Olympics, winning men's singles bronze at Atlanta 1996, before going on to become one of the all-time great doubles players, building a formidable partnership alongside Mahesh Bhupathi.

The trailblazing Mirza would follow them among tennis's elite, shattering all sorts of stereotypes to become the most successful female player India had since the 1980s, before going on to win six Grand Slam doubles titles.

In the shadow of the success of the individual medal at the Olympics, winning men's singles bronze at Atlanta 1996, before going on to become one of the all-time great doubles players, building a formidable partnership alongside Mahesh Bhupathi.
